The Kern County Planning and Community Development Department (the Planning Department) has prepared a draft environmental impact report (EIR) for **Beacon Photovoltaic Project by Beacon Solar LLC** (PP12213), requesting approval of Conditional Use Permit (CUP) 11, Map 152, to allow for the construction and operation of a 250 megawatt (MW) photovoltaic (PV) solar facility in unincorporated eastern Kern County. The project site is located four miles from California City, 15 miles north of the unincorporated town of Mojave, and less than one mile southwest of the unincorporated town of Cantil/Rancho Seco (within Sections 4, 7, 8 & 9, Township 31 S, Range 37 E, MDB&M)

The project would consist of a 2,298-acre PV solar facility including an estimated 972,000 PV solar panels, an operation and maintenance (O&M) building, as well as transmission lines to connect the solar facility with the nearby Barren Ridge Substation. The total project area is 2,301 acres – 2,298 acres for the solar facility and 3.3 acres for the transmission line footprint.

The Planning and Community Development Department, as the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), has determined that preparation of an EIR would be appropriate for the referenced projects. Enclosed is a copy of the draft EIR.

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY FOR PUBLIC REVIEW**

This is to advise that the Kern County Planning and Community Development Department has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the project identified below. As mandated by State law, the minimum public review period for this document is 45 days. The document and documents referenced in the DEIR are available for review at the Planning and Community Development Department, 2700 "M" Street, Suite 100, Bakersfield, CA 93301, or on the Departmental website (<http://www.co.kern.ca.us/planning/eirs.asp>).

A public hearing has been scheduled with the Kern County Planning Commission to receive comments on the document on **September 27, 2012** at 7:00 p.m. or soon thereafter, Chambers of the Board of Supervisors, First Floor, Kern County Administrative Center, 1115 Truxtun Avenue, Bakersfield, California. The comment period for this document closes on **August 24, 2012**. Testimony at future public hearings may be limited to those issues raised during the public review period either orally or submitted in writing by 5:00 p.m. the day the comment period closes

PROJECT TITLE: The **Beacon Photovoltaic Project by Beacon Solar LLC** (PP 12213) includes:

CUP 11, Map 152, to allow for the construction and operation of a 250 megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic facility of renewable electrical energy including an estimated 972,000 PV solar panels, an operation and maintenance (O&M) building on 2,301 acres in unincorporated, southeastern Kern County.

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is located four miles from California City, 15 miles north of the unincorporated town of Mojave, and less than one mile southwest of the unincorporated town of Cantil/Rancho Seco (within Sections 4, 7, 8 & 9, Township 31 S, Range 37 E, MDB&M)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed Beacon Photovoltaic Project by Beacon Solar LLC would develop a 250 megawatt (MW) photovoltaic (PV) solar facility in unincorporated eastern Kern County. The project would consist of a 2,298-acre PV solar facility and a transmission line to connect the solar facility with the nearby Barren Ridge Substation. The total project area is 2,301 acres – 2,298 acres for the solar facility and 3.3 acres for the transmission line footprint.

The majority of the project site is located within the Kern County General Plan area and the northernmost portion of the site is located within the Cantil Interim Community Plan area. The project site and the surrounding areas are primarily undeveloped disturbed lands, formerly used for agricultural activities. The project proposes to connect to the existing LADWP Barren Ridge substation located one mile to the southwest. The Honda Proving Ground, an automotive test track, is located roughly 3/4 mile east of the project site. In addition, a Southern California Edison (SCE) distribution line crosses the property. The project proponent is requesting a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to allow for the construction and operation of solar electrical generating facility in the A (Exclusive Agriculture) and A-1 (Limited Agriculture) zone districts. Encroachment permits for access via public roads, and possible franchise agreements associated with connecting to the local utility grid along County rights-of-way may also be required to implement the proposed solar facility project. An Operations and Maintenance (O&M) building is also proposed as part of the project.

The Beacon Photovoltaic Solar Project by Beacon Solar LLC (proposed project) would develop photovoltaic (PV) solar facility with about 972,000 PV solar panels that would generate 250 megawatts (MW) of renewable electrical energy on a total 2,301 acres of undeveloped and previously disturbed land, including 2,298 acres of solar arrays and 3 miles of transmission lines, in unincorporated, southeastern Kern County (within Sections 4, 7, 8 & 9, Township 31 S, Range 37 E, MDB&M). The majority of the project site is located within the Kern County General Plan area and the northernmost portion of the site is located within the Cantil Interim Community Plan area. The project site is located four miles from California City, 15 miles north of the unincorporated town of Mojave, and less than one mile southwest of the unincorporated town of Cantil/Rancho Seco. The project site and the surrounding areas are primarily undeveloped disturbed lands, formerly used for agricultural activities. SR 14 runs near the western border of the

project site, and an existing Union Pacific rail line runs through the project site. An existing Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) electrical transmission line runs roughly in parallel to SR 14 about one mile further to the west. The project proposes to connect to the existing LADWP Barren Ridge substation located one mile to the southwest. The Honda Proving Ground, an automotive test track, is located roughly 3/4 mile east of the project site. In addition, a Southern California Edison (SCE) distribution line crosses the property.

The project proponent requests approval of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to allow for the construction and operation of solar electrical generating facility in the A (Exclusive Agriculture) and A-1 (Limited Agriculture) zone districts. The portion of the property that is zoned as Platted Lands will only be used for the transmission line. Encroachment permits for access via public roads, and possible franchise agreements associated with connecting to the local utility grid along County rights-of-way may also be required to implement the proposed solar facility project. An Operations and Maintenance (O&M) building is also proposed as part of the project.


